Texas Department of State Health Services –

Texas requirements for initial certification/licensure:

- At least 18 years old
- Complete high school or GED certificate (Texas Education Agency approved or out-of-state equivalent)
- Successful completion of a DSHS approved EMS training course
- Submit EMS Personnel Certification Application and fee
- Pass National Registry exam
- To gain paramedic licensure status, you are required to follow the steps above and submit proof of either a two-year EMS degree or a four-year degree in any field.
- Submit fingerprints through the Fingerprint Applicant Services of Texas (FAST) for Texas/FBI criminal history check. To schedule your fingerprinting, see [L-1 Identity Solutions- Texas Locations](#). (\$44.20)
